What is Le Sutra? In Sanskrit, Sutra means a rope or thread which binds things together.

Le Sutra - the world's first Indian art hotel in Mumbai, India, weaves spirituality into the experience, with each room depicting a different character and diverse characteristics.

For instance, the Karna Room, dedicated to an epic hero from the Mahabharata, one of India's scriptures, portrays characteristics like valor, truth, forgiveness and kindness.

Inspired by a powerful and learned King who had mastered the Vedas and Upanishads and was a devout devotee of Lord Shiva, the Ravana Room depicts strength, knowledge, power and grandeur.

NIRVAN ROOM

The room depicting Nirvan which means unconditioned mind, portrays the spirit of enlightenment as explained by Buddha - the Awakened One.

Buddha describes Nirvana as a state of mind that has reached a point of clarity and lucidity and in which one ceases to actively make choices and decisions. It is a state of Beingness in which we are led into thought and action by the Divine Will.

SRINGAR ROOM

The 'Sringar' Room depicts the art of adornment, romance, beauty and pleasure. Sringar is also the coming together of grace and beauty.

PRAKRITI ROOM

The Prakriti Room explores creation, which encompasses all that is the material world.

The three gunas or qualities and attributes are a part of Prakriti. Even our desires, thoughts and moments of intelligence flashing through our minds are a part of prakriti or creation.

VAASNA ROOM

'Vaasna' means 'sensuality' in Sanskrit. The Vaasna Room depicts that all creation is the balance of opposites - light and dark, positive and negative, dynamic and kinetic.

MAYA ROOM

The Maya Room depicts illusion. Maya in Sanskrit means 'that which is not'. It is a state in which each individual soul, under a sense of false identity considers itself to be separate and distinct from the supreme consciousness and the rest of the creation.

SHUDDHI ROOM

Shuddhi means cleansing which means getting rid of the impurities at a gross and

subtle level.

As an individual transcends weakness, temptations and desires of each of the lower chakras his or her Kundalini or consciousness level rises.

SATTVIC, RAJASIC & TAMASIC FLOORS

Le Sutra - the 16-room boutique hotel is split into three floors - Sattvic, Rajasic and Tamasic which represent the three Gunas or aspects of human nature which also form the basis of creation.

Gunas also means a rope or thread and it is sometimes said that beings are roped or tied to matter by the three Gunas of material nature...

"Every brick, artifact, stairway and corridor of Le Sutra captures the evolution of the human spirit and its relationship with creation by portraying the various attributes of human nature or gunas with a brilliant use of color, design, murals and décor," said Bajaj.

"Through the shadows of time and the depths of creation, Le Sutra journeys into the Soul and various levels of existence, using a skillful use of symbols and symbolism, vedic mantras and mandalas," he added.
